### Waterloo Campus Committee Ministry Report— April, 2015

- This Committee has has engaged in 2 retreats over the last year, serving as an appraisal of the current structure of the campus committee. The following reflects areas where we want to grow:
  - 1. Orientation of new members. We will write a new handbook which includes The HM handbook. I mentioned that the distance between members made things difficult loss of momentum, etc. See below for details. Could a chair be an accountability partner for the members of the committee?
  - 2. **Membership Needs and requirements.** Brian asks that the financial support could use some bolstering. Not in the day to day signing of expenses, etc., but in the fundraising, and connection w/ Classis & Home Missions.

Lesli outlined a potential break-down of membership.

9 members, not including students.

Membership from outside the CRC is already in the Classis constitution

— we should move on Drayton RCA and Knox Presbyterian

Action items for roles/membership:

- Lesli will bring the need for another Classis rep to CMC.
- Rudy will ask Bruce to find a Waterloo rep. He may suggest to Bruce that the two of them will encourage Peter VanBeek.
- Rudy will also talk w/ Greg Sennema
- Brian will ask John Medendorp
- Brian will check w/ Chantal as a grad student rep
- Albert will check with Drayton RCA
- 3. Clarify Roles Do we know why we're on the campus committee?

Representation of a particular constituency is important — relate what's happening on campus to the churches that are farther away from campus

- We ought to develop ways for committee members to make these connections
  - Action item: carve out Classis, and see how we can make connections. Develop promotional materials —we're representing Waterloo, but we're also representing campus ministry in general.
  - Carve out Classis in terms of personnel and have committee members connect w/ youth ministers, youth leaders, and pastors who do youth ministry.

- 3. Not just Classis but local Christian high schools, too.
- 4. Campus committee member to follow the HM funding. Know what the forecast is for the upcoming year.

### 4. **Connections** — See "Roles" for Classis and regional connections

- 1. Home Missions is there a way to support Home Missions?
  - 1. At the very least, we should have Mark (the HM rep) visit our committee once a year to give an update.
  - Could we host a conference sometime around AOYC where campus boards come together to meet with Darren Roorda, Mark Wallace, Syd Hielema and hear about the future of campus ministry & the structure of the denomination? Questions about insurance, liability, charitable status, technical questions, too.
    - 1. Action: Lesli will ask Syd about this.
    - 2. Action: Brian will connect w/ Mark about this.
    - 3. Action: Brian will mention this at the April regional campus meeting.
